

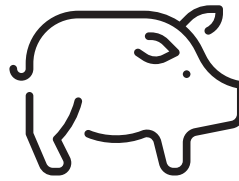
QUICK TIPS

For preventing COVID-19 on your operation or farm.



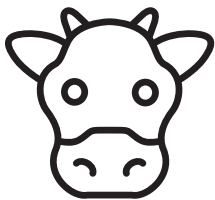
BEEKEEPING

Suit up and mask up.
Assign a bee suit to each individual and don't share.



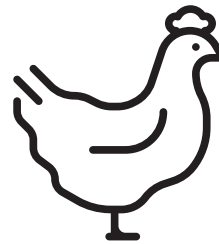
HOGS

Mask up and/or keep a safe distance from other workers.



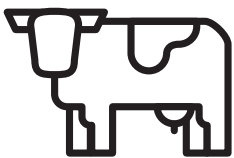
CATTLE

For processing, mask up or space workers 2m apart.



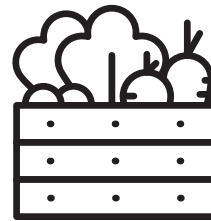
POULTRY

Mask up, and glove up if required.



DAIRY

Stay 2m apart or on opposite ends of the parlour or barn when milking.



VEGETABLE FARM

Mask up and glove up. Consider spacing out the picking/packaging line and wear face shields or hang plexiglass dividers.



GRAIN

Try to assign one worker to one specific vehicle. Sanitize all levers, controls, GPS screens, baler monitors, door handles, and steering wheels after each shift.



MANAGING WORKERS

Clean common areas often, stagger breaks, provide hand sanitizer where hand washing is not possible.

Always start with a risk assessment to determine the level of risk and hazard posed by the work. Ensure all Personal Protective Equipment used is appropriate for the work hazards (i.e., cloth masks do not work well for dust and gloves are not appropriate in all circumstances). In order to provide adequate protection, masks need to fit properly; especially when the mask is required to protect the worker from such hazards as dusts or fumes.
