Part 20 Radiation Exposure	<p>Prevention and protection</p> <p>291 If workers may be exposed to ionizing radiation at a work site, an employer must</p> <p>(a) develop and implement safe work practices and procedures to be used when the workers deal with or approach the radiation source,</p> <p>(b) if practicable, involve the workers in the development and implementation of the safe work practices and procedures, and</p> <p>(c) inform the workers of the potential hazards of ionizing radiation and the radiation source.</p>	Workers exposed to ionizing radiation can have serious and long lasting injury or illness.	L	M	L	<p>Although unlikely on a farm or ranch, employers should be aware of the radiation warning symbol and whether any industrial activity on the farm (oil and gas) has potential radiation exposure.</p> <p>Care should be taken to ensure employees are not exposed to radiation.</p> <p>If a radiation emitting device is used on the farm, employees must be trained on safe handling procedures to minimize exposure.</p>
