<p>Contents of plan</p>	<p>116 An emergency response plan must include the following:</p> <p>(a) the identification of potential emergencies;</p> <p>(b) procedures for dealing with the identified emergencies;</p> <p>(c) the identification of, location of and operational procedures for emergency equipment;</p> <p>(d) the emergency response training requirements;</p> <p>(e) the location and use of emergency facilities;</p> <p>(f) the fire protection requirements;</p> <p>(g) the alarm and emergency communication requirements;</p> <p>(h) the first aid services required;</p> <p>(i) procedures for rescue and evacuation;</p> <p>(j) the designated rescue and evacuation workers.</p>	<p>Having the right information in the Emergency Response Plan will dramatically increase your ability to deal with an emergency or rescue resulting in faster care for injuries</p>	L	L	L	<p>Ensure the required emergency information is clearly documented in your Emergency Response Plan.</p> <p>AgSafe to develop templates for emergency response plans including details such as direction to the farm, field and/or land location.</p>
<p>Rescue and evacuation workers</p>	<p>117(1) An employer must designate the workers who will provide rescue services and supervise evacuation procedures in an emergency.</p> <p>117(2) An employer must ensure that designated</p>	<p>Trained people are required on the site to ensure a rescue or emergency evacuation can be successfully carried out. Improperly trained people can increase the hazard level either to themselves or the injured persons.</p>	L	L	L	<p>There must be a designated person on site who is trained to coordinate rescue services and supervise an evacuation in the case of an emergency. The</p>

	<p>rescue and emergency workers are trained in emergency response appropriate to the work site and the potential emergencies identified in the emergency response plan.</p> <p>117(3) The training under subsection (2) must include exercises appropriate to the work site that simulate the potential emergencies identified in the emergency response plan.</p> <p>117(4) The training exercises referred to in subsection (3) must be repeated at the intervals required to ensure that the designated rescue and evacuation workers are competent to carry out their duties.</p>					designated person and any emergency workers are appropriately trained for potential emergencies at the site and this training must include regular simulation training to be competent to carry out the necessary duties.
Equipment	<p>118(1) An employer must provide workers designated under section 117 with personal protective clothing and equipment appropriate to the work site and the potential emergencies identified in the emergency response plan.</p> <p>118(2) Workers who respond to an emergency must wear and use personal protective clothing and equipment appropriate to the work site and the emergency.</p>	Proper personal protection clothing and equipment are needed to respond safely to identified situations in the Emergency Response Plan.
